On 6 December 2008, Alexandros Grigoropoulos (16 years old) dies after being shot by a police officer in Exarchia, Athens. A social revolt follows. Four years later, the directorial group named "Χάι Λάιφ" seeks answers to the question *What was finally December 2008?* via a [documentary](#).
